## **Catching Butterflies Card Instruction Sheet**



#### **Card Cuts:**

- Card Base Cut 1, Basic White Cardstock measuring 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" and scored at 4-1/4"
- Card Sentiment Cut 1, Basic White Cardstock measuring approximately 3" x 3/4"
- Card Panel (front) Cut 1, Polished Pink Cardstock measuring 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"

- Card Panel (front) Cut 1 of each at 5-2/8" x 4"
  - Basic White Cardstock
  - Pansy Petals Designer Series Paper (DSP)
- Fussy Cut Dress for Little Girl Cut 1, Pansy Petals DSP measuring approximately 3" x 4"
- Little Girl/Butterfly Image Cut 1, Basic White Cardstock measuring approximately 3" x 4"
- Card Panel (inside) Cut 1, Polished Pink Cardstock measuring 4-1/8" x 5-3/8"
- Card Panel (inside) Cut 1, Basic White Cardstock measuring 5-2/8" x 4"
- Envelope Flap Cut 1, Pansy Petals DSP measuring approximately 6" x 2-1/2"
- Additional cuts are made using the Stitched So Sweetly Dies see specific instructions below for these cuts.

#### Instructions:

- Glue the Polished Pink panel to the front of the card base
- Glue the Pansy Petals DSP panel (Designer Series Paper) to the Basic White cardstock panel.
   This will provide the DSP with some stability when cutting out the window.
- Using the largest rectangle die from the Stitched So Sweetly Dies, cut out the window from the DSP/Basic White panel that were glued together. Cut this window out before adhering panels to the front of the card! The placement of the window cut out is approximately 3/8" from the top and 5/8" from each side do your best to center the die from side-to-side, being sure to leave room at the bottom of the card for the sentiment. Using Stamping Dimensionals, adhere this panel to the front of the card, on top of the Polished Pink panel.
- From the Catching Butterflies stamp set, stamp the image of the Little Girl in Momento Tuxedo Black ink, the single butterfly in Polished Pink ink, and the grass (two times) in Evening Evergreen ink onto the 3" x 4" piece of white cardstock.
- Stamp the image of the little girl onto the 3" x 4" piece of DSP. You can stamp in black or Smoky Slate. Fussy cut the dress from the stamped image. Adhere the dress you just cut from the DSP to the stamped and colored white cardstock image of the little girl. Hint: When fussy cutting around curves, it's easier to move the paper, rather than the scissors. I recommend using small, sharp paper snips or scissors for fussy cutting.
- Using the second-to-largest rectangular Stitched So Sweetly die, cut out the colored image of the little girl/butterfly/grass. Glue this piece to the front of the card centering in the window.
- The greeting is from the Catching Butterflies stamp set and was stamped onto a 3/4" x 3" piece
  of Basic White Cardstock. I then used the Banners Pick A Punch on each end of the banner to
  give it a flag appearance. Use Mini Glue Dots to adhere a 3-1/2" piece of Black Glittered
  Organdy Ribbon under the card's window, then use Stampin' Dimensionals to pop up the
  greeting.
- Place three of the Rhinestone Basic Jewels on the Little Girl panel. I placed mine to the left of the little girl but you can place yours wherever you'd like.
- For the inside of the card, use Polished Pink ink to stamp the image of multiple butterflies in the bottom right-hand corner and the top left-hand corner. Stamp image first on a scrap piece of paper before stamping on the white cardstock (this is called Stamping Off).
- Adhere the 6" x 2-1/2" piece of DSP to the outside flap of the envelope then fussy cut around the envelope flap.
