Flowering Rain Boots Card - Instruction Sheet



Card Cuts:

- Card Base Evening Evergreen Cardstock Cut 1 at 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", score at 4-1/4"
- Mat (outside of card) Basic White Cardstock Cut 1 at 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"
- Mat (inside of card) Basic White Cardstock Cut 1 at 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"
- Heart & Home DSP (outside of card) Cut 1 at 5-1/4" x 4"
- Scrap piece of Smokey Slate Cardstock for stamping and die cutting boots
- Scrap piece of Smokey Slate Cardstock for die cutting garden rake
- Scrap piece of Basic White Cardstock for stamping and die cutting flower pot and flowers

Coordinating Heart & Home DSP for envelope flap – Cut 1 at approximately 3" x 6"

Making the Card:

- I didn't have any Fresh Fresia ribbon on hand so I first cut a length of Faux White Ribbon (from the Flower for Every Season Ribbon Combo Pack) and with a sponge dauber, inked Fresh Fresia ink onto the ribbon. Do this first because you'll need to give the ink plenty of time of dry.
- Next, stamp the boots in Tuexedo Black Memento ink onto the scrap piece of Smokey Slate cardstock.
- Stamp the flowerpot onto a scrap piece of Basic White Cardstock in Cinnamon Cider ink.
- Stamp the flowers onto a scrap piece of Basic White Cardstock in Fresh Fresia ink.
- Die cut all stamped images, including die cutting of the garden rake (no inked image for this).
- Stamp the sentiment for the front of the card onto a piece of Fresh Fresia cardstock. Use the Label Me Fancy punch to cut the sentiment.
- Using Stampin' Seal, place a small amount on the back side, bottom portion of the piece of DSP on the right and left. You will wrap the ribbon ends to each side of the back of the DSP. I placed the bottom edge of the ribbon approximately a ½" to ½" from the bottom of the DSP.
- Using Multipurpose Glue, adhere the piece of DSP (after ribbon is secured in place) to the Basic White cardstock mat.
- Dry fit the die cut pieces and greeting to the piece of DSP. I place the boots on the left, the flower pot and flowers on the right and the greeting in the upper right-hand corner of the DSP.
- When you're happy with placement, use Stampin' Dimensionals to the boots and flower pot/flowers and place on DSP.
- Use several mini glue dots rolled up and place under the garden rake to support and adhere above the stamped greeting. Now, use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the sentiment to the front of the card.
- Using Rhinestone Basic Jewels, I placed a small jewel in the center of each stamped flower and one jewel on the sentiment tag (to the left and above the sentiment).
- On the Basic White cardstock mat for the inside of the card, stamp the flowers in Fresh Fresia
 in the lower right hand corner, then second generation stamp the same image to the right and
 left of the first generation stamp.



- Using Multipurpose Glue, adhere the mat to the inside of the card. Stamping an additional greeting inside of the card is optional.
- Using a piece of coordinating DSP approximately 3" x 6", adhere to the envelope flap with Multipurpose Glue and fussy cut around the flap.

The card is complete!
