Heart and Home Card - Instruction Sheet



Card Cuts:

- Card Base Basic White Cardstock 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", score at 4-1/4"
- Mat for front of Card Heart and Home Designer Series Paper in Fresh Fresia design 4-1/8" x 5-3/8"
- Inside of Card Fresh Fresia Cardstock 4-1/8" x 5-3/8"
- Envelope Flap Heart and Home Designer Series Paper in Fresh Fresia design 2-1/2" x 6"

- Miscellaneous Flower Die Cuts Basic White Cardstock scraps
- Flower panels and sentiment tag Fresh Fresia Cardstock Cut from Stitched So Sweetly Dies. The 3rd smallest rectangle was used for the flower panels and the 2nd from largest tag from this set was used for the sentiment.

Making the Card:

- I first stamped the bee from the Honeybee Home Stamp Set and colored the bee in with Daffodil Delight Stampin' Blends as well as Crumb Cake Stampin' Blends and a Basic Black Stampin' Write Marker, then used the Honeybee Blooms die to cut him out. The bee image was stamped with Black Momento ink but I used the marker to darken the tips of the bee's feet, head and black stripes on his body.
- I die cut various flower sprigs from the Flowers of Home Die set using Basic White Cardstock.
 Note: I saved the piece of white cardstock that I used to die cut the flowers from...more on this later.
- I die cut three of the rectangular panels from the Stitched So Sweetly Die set, using the third smallest rectangular die from Fresh Fresia Cardstock
- I also cut the second from the largest sentiment tag from the Stitched So Sweetly Die set in Fresh Fresia.
- I began coloring the flower images cut from Basic White Cardstock and used Stampin' Blends in Pumpkin Pie, Doffodil Delight and Granny Apple Green.
- I used the piece of white cardstock I had cut the flower images from as a stencil. Using Smokey Slate and a sponge dauber, I sponged a gray shadow of the flower images onto the Fresh Fresia rectangles that I had cut. This gives the feeling of shadow and depth to the panels. (see images below)





- After stenciling in these flower "shadows" I then dry fit the flower pieces and when I was happy
 with their arrangement, I used liquid glue to adhere each of the flower sprigs to each of the
 three Fresh Fresia panels.
- I then glued the three panels to the piece of DSP mat keeping the panels towards the top of the card.

- Before gluing down the DSP mat to the card base I wrapped Linen Thread around the bottom portion of the card twice, using Stampin' Seal on each side on the back to hold the thread down. Once the thread was secured, I glued the mat to the card base.
- I used a Stampin' Dimensional under the bee and placed the bee over top of the flower on the center panel.
- I stamped a sentiment from the Honeybee Home Stamp Set on the Fresh Fresia tag I had die cut earlier. I used Fresh Fresia Stampin' Blends around the outside of the sentiment tage, then used Stampin' Dimensionals to pop up the sentiment to the center bottom of the card front.
- I then used several Rhinestone Basic Jewels on the front of the card.
- On the inside of the card I adhered the Fresh Fresia panel down. I used a stamped and die cut flower image on the inside of the card and colored in with Daffodil Delight and Granny Apple Green Stampin' Blends (not shown).
- Lastly, I glued a piece of the Fresh Fresia DSP from the Heart and Home DSP pack to the envelope flap and fussy cut around the envelope flap.

Our card is complete!
