
Blessings of Home Z Fold Card Project Sheet

This card features the large image from the Blessings of Home stamp set. This beautiful image is colored in Fresh Fesia and really pops against the Smokey Slate and black backdrops. Enjoy!

Card Cuts:

Card Front

- Card Base – Cut 1 Smokey Slate cardstock to 11" x 4-1/4", score at 5-1/2" and 2-3/4"
- Mat #1 – Cut 1 Basic Black to 4-7/8" x 3-5/8"
- Mat #2 – Cut 1 Heart & Home DSP to 4-3/4" x 3-1/2"
- Sentiment Label – Cut 1 Basic White to approximately 3-1/4" x 3/4"
- Basic White Cardstock scraps for stamping and die cutting flower image

Inside of Card

- Mat #1 – Cut 1 Basic Black to 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"
- Mat #2 – Cut 1 Basic White to 5-1/4" x 4"
- Mat #3 – Cut 1 Heart & Home DSP to 2-5/8" x 4-1/8"

Envelope Flap

- Coordinating Heart & Home DSP – Cut 1 at 2-3/4" x 6"

Assembling the Card:

Card Front

- Stamp the large flower image from the Blessings of Home onto a piece of Basic White cardstock.
- Using Stampin' Blends, color the image.
 - Flowers
 - Use Fresh Fesia on flower petals. Use the dark shade of Fresh Fesia for all petals in shadow. Use the light shade of Smokey Slate to deepen the shadows, then blend again with Fresh Fesia to soften the lines.
 - Color centers of flowers with Daffodil Delight and use the dark shade of Pumpkin Pie Stampin' Blends to darken the centers. Blend again with Daffodil Delight to soften.
 - Cluster of Small Flowers – Color flowers in Balmy Blue and color centers of these small flowers with the dark shade of Pumpkin Pie.
 - Leaves – Color with light shade of Granny Apple Green, then color the portion of leaves that are falling in shadow with the dark shade of Mossy Meadow. Blend again with Granny Apple Green to soften the lines where you shaded.



- Using the coordinating die from the Flowers of Home die set, cut out the flower image you just colored.
- Adhere Mat #2 for front of card (DSP) to Mat #1 (Basic Black)
- Using Stampin' Dimensionals, adhere the flower image to the front of these panels, placing at an angle and to the left of the panel.
- Stamp the sentiment onto the small piece of Basic White cardstock and cut to size if needed. Place Stampin' Dimensionals on only the end that will not overlap the flower image and place on lower right of card front panel, overlapping the flower image.
- Tie a small bow from the Black Organdy Glitter Ribbon and using a Mini Glue Dot, adhere to the top left corner of the card front panel.
- Using Multipurpose Liquid Glue, adhere the card front panel to the front Z fold of the card, making sure that there is an equal distance all around.

Inside of Card

- Stamp a portion of the flower bouquet image in the upper left of the white cardstock mat.
- Color the image the same as you did for the front of the card.
- Adhere Mat #2 (Basic White) to Mat #1 (Black). Adhere this panel to the inside of the card.

Envelope

- Stamp a portion of the flower bouquet image in the lower right on the front of the envelope.
Important: Be sure to place a scrap piece of cardstock inside of the envelope before coloring the image as the Stampin' Blends will bleed through the paper of the envelope.

- Using Multipurpose Liquid Glue, adhere coordinating piece of DSP to card flap, then fussy cut around envelope flap to finish.

The card is complete! The Fresh Fnesia flowers really pop against the Smokey Slate!
