Daffodil Daydream Card - Instruction Sheet



I played around with the Daffodil Daydream Bundle today. Don't let all of the die pieces in this set intimidate you. Take a look at the catalog card samples and the dies are easy to figure out. Let's get started.

Card Cuts:

Card Base

• Card Base – Pale Papaya – Cut 1 at 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", score at 4-1/4"

Card Mats & Sentiment Label

- Daffodil Afternoon 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper, print with daffodils and black background - Cut 1 at 4" x 5-1/4"
- Daffodil Afternoon DSP, print with black background and small + signs Cut 1 using largest rectangular die from the Stitched So Sweetly Die set
- Daffodil Afternoon DSP, print with Pale Papaya background and Very Vanilla polka dots Cut 1 using the largest label die from the Stitched So Sweetly Die set
- Very Vanilla Cardstock Cut 1 using the second to smallest label die from the Stitched So Sweetly Die set

Daffodils, Stems, Leaves and Butterfly

Following the image below cut 1 from each die shown in the diagram. The die groups are numbered and correspond to the daffodil that those dies make on the card, plus the butterfly die pieces.



- The daffodil petals were cut in Very Vanilla
- The daffodil cups and bud were cut in Pale Papaya
- The stems and leaves were cut in Granny Apple Green (not shown in diagram)
 - Stems Cut 2 that point right
 - Stem Cut 1 that points left
 - Leaves Cut 2 that point left
 - Leaf Cut 1 that points right
- o Butterfly Cut 1 of each die piece. The small and large wings were cut in Fresh Fresia. The body of the butterfly was cut in Basic Black cardstock

Inside of Card

Mat – Cut 1 in Very Vanilla at 4" x 5-1/4"

Envelope Flap

 Daffodil Afternoon DSP, print with Pale Papaya background and Very Vanilla polka dots – Cut 1 at 2-3/4" x 6"

Making the Card:

Front of Card

- Adhere the Daffodil Afternoon DSP piece measuring 4" x 5-1/4 to the front of the card base.
- Adhere the die cut piece of Daffodil Afternoon DSP (black background with plus signs) from the largest Stitched So Sweetly rectangular die to the front of the card base. Center this piece of DSP from right to left, and approximately ½" from the top of the card base.
- Assemble the die cut pieces for each flower. Note that the daffodil dies have a more solid
 petal die and a die that has frills on the edges and cut outs. The frilly die cut pieces get
 assembled on top of the more solid die cuts. The same applies to the daffodil bud the solid
 piece goes on the bottom with the cutout piece on top.
 - O I used the Dark Pumpkin Pie Stampin' Blend to darken each "frilly" die cut piece (the pieces that are glued on top of the sold die cut flower pieces). I could have cut the pieces from Pumpkin Pie cardstock but I didn't have any on hand so the Stampin' Blends work well for this purpose.



- After the flowers and bud are assembled, using liquid glue, you can then then attach a stem to
 each flower and the bud using glue. The stems are too long for this card and you will trim each
 stem down in a bit.
- Next, dry fit the two daffodil flowers, bud and leaves onto the card. I arranged mine so that all
 pieces met towards the bottom center of the black and Very Vanilla piece of DSP. When
 you're happy with your arrangement, start gluing down each flower, the bud, and the leaves.
 NOTE: Do not place glue on any stems that fall below the black and Very Vanilla piece
 of DSP.
- Now you'll want to trim the stems and leaves with your paper snips cutting off at the bottom
 of the piece of DSP that was cut from the Stitched So Sweetly rectangle.
- Wrap a piece of ribbon around the card from top to bottom and tie a bow. I placed my ribbon on the left side of the card front.
- Stamp the sentiment on the smaller die cut label using Tuxedo Black Memento ink, then glue this label onto the larger die cut label center. Apply Stampin' Dimensionals to the back side of the sentiment label and apply to the lower center of the card front. **This label will hide** where you trimmed off your stems and leaves.
- Assemble the butterfly. The butterfly was initially cut from Very Vanilla cardstock. I used
 Fresh Fresia Stampin' Blends to color the top wings in the light shade and the bottom wings in
 the dark shade of Fresh Fresia. Glue the small die cut wings to the large die cut wings –
 gluing only down the middle where the butterflie's body would be. Now, glue the Basic Black
 die cut body on top. I slightly bent each set of wings up on each side. Apply a Stampin'
 Dimensional to the back of the butterfly in the middle and apply to card.
- Add a few Opal Rounds to the card and the card front is complete.

Inside of Card

- Using the "dots" stamp from the Daffodil Daydream stamp set, stamp across the bottom in Pale Papaya ink on the Very Vanilla mat.
- Stamp your desired sentiment.

Envelope

- Using the "dots" stamp (same as used on the inside of the card mat), stamp along the bottom edge of the front of the envelope in Pale Papaya.
- Using the 2-3/4" x 6" piece of DSP pattern from the Daffodil Afternoon DSP (Pale Papaya background and Very Vanilla polka dots), glue to the envelope flap and fussy cut around the flap.

The card is complete!
