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Honeybee Home Card Project Sheet

I asked friends on my Facebook page to let me know which card they like better – the card with Pale Papaya accents or the card with Smokey Slate accents. The winner is...Honeybee Home card with Pale Papaya accents! Both versions are lovely, though. **This project sheet will list supplies for the Pale Papaya version only.**



Card Cuts:

Card Front

- Card Base – Cut 1 Basic Black cardstock to 11" x 4-1/4", score at 5-1/2"
- Mat for Front of Card – Cut 1 Pale Papaya cardstock to 4" x 5-1/4"

- DSP Mat for Front of Card – Cut 1 to 5" x 3-3/4"
- Heart & Home DSP – Cut 1 to approximately 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"
- Die Cut Circle – Cut 1 Pale Papaya to approximately 3" x 3"
- Sentiment Label – Cut 1 to 3" x 1"
- Basic White Cardstock scraps for die cutting flowers

Inside of Card

- Mat – Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to 4" x 5-1/4"

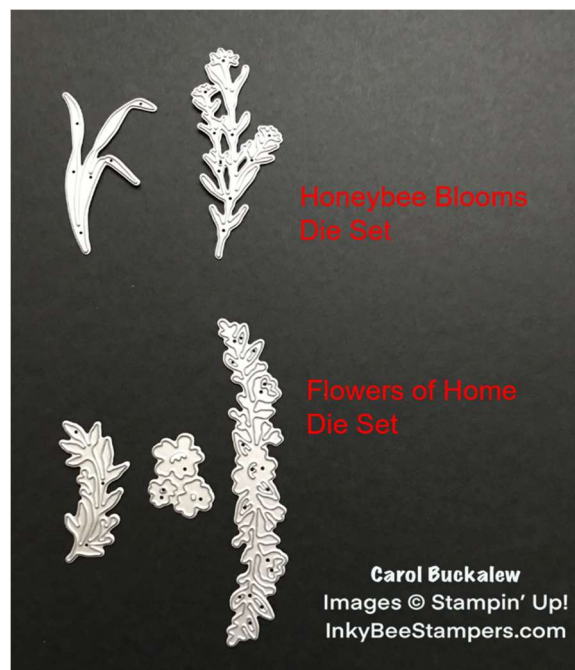
Envelope Flap

- Coordinating Heart & Home DSP – Cut 1 at 2-3/4" x 6"

Assembling the Card:

Card Front

- Using the Stampin' Cut & Emboss machine, die cut the following. See image below.
 - Grass from the Honeybee Blooms die set in Basic White – Cut 1
 - Tall Flower from the Honeybee Blooms die set in Basic White – Cut 1
 - 3-Flowers from the Flowers of Home die set in Basic White – Cut 1
 - Foliage from the Flowers of Home die set in Basic White – Cut 1
 - Arched flower wreath from the Flowers of Home die set in Basic White – Cut 1
 - 2-3/4" circle from the Layered Circles die set in Pale Papaya – Cut 1
 - 2-1/4" circle from the Layered Circles die set in wood floor DSP – Cut 1



- Adhere the Pale Papaya mat onto the Basic Black card base.

- Adhere the DSP 2-14" circle to the 2-3/4" Pale Papaya circle making sure that there is an equal reveal all around.
- Dry fit and then glue down the white flowers (grass, tall flower, and medium sized foliage/flower) onto the circle. Allow the flowers/foliage to extend past the center DSP circle.
- Using Stampin' Dimensionals, pop up the circle, placing bottom center of card. Leave approximately a 1/4" between the bottom of the circle and the bottom edge of the card base.
Note: the tallest flower will be extending past the circle edge and it is delicate! Using your snips, cut a very small piece of Stampin' Dimensional and place under the flower head that is hanging over the circle edge. Allow the flower head to adhere to the DSP mat. This will give the flower some stability.
- Stamp the sentiment onto the 3" x 1" piece of Pale Papaya cardstock. Using the Banners Pick A Punch, punch each end of the sentiment label.
- Adhere the arched flower wreath to the top of the sentiment label, then adhere both to the top portion of the card. I angled my sentiment label. If you prefer to have the sentiment label straight, the wreath will fit completely on the card without hanging over the edges – but just barely, so check placement before gluing.
- Adhere the three small flowers to the card front. See photo on page 1 for placement.
- Tie a double bow from linen thread and trim ends even to bottom of card.
- Adhere a Matte Black dot to the sentiment label.

Inside of Card

- Stamp the bumblebee from the Honeybee Home Stamp Set in Pale Papaya ink in the bottom right corner of the Basic White mat.
- Adhere the Basic White mat to the inside of the card.

Envelope

- Stamp the bumblebee from the Honeybee Home Stamp Set in Pale Papaya ink on the front of the envelope in the bottom right corner.
- Using Multipurpose Liquid Glue, adhere coordinating piece of DSP to card flap, then fussy cut around envelope flap to finish.
