# **New Horizons Green Meadow Card**

Here is another quick and easy card made with the New Horizons 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper. Other than coordinating solid color mats under the DSP, no embellishments were used...or needed, but you can add as desired.



### **Card Cuts:**

#### **Card Front**

• Card Base – Cut 1 Thick Basic White cardstock to 11" x 4-1/4", score at 5-1/2"

- Mat for Front of Card Cut 1 Misty Moonlight cardstock to 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"
- Card Front Cut 1 New Horizons green meadow/blue sky pattern paper to 5" x 3-3/4".

#### Inside of Card

- Coordinating DSP for Inside of Card Cut 1 at 1" x 5-1/4"
- Mat for inside of Card Cut 1 in Basic White to 4" x 5-1/4". Note: When cutting this 1" strip, I made sure to get some of the green hills and sky in the strip.

## Envelope Flap

• Coordinating DSP – Cut 1 at 2-3/4" x 6"


## **Assembling the Card:**

#### Card Front

- I used stamps from the Friendly Hello and Dahlia Days stamp sets to stamp greenery in the lower right and left-hand corners of the 5" x 3-3/4" piece of DSP in Tuxedo Black Memento Ink. Stamping these images in the lower corners of the scene bring them to the forefront of the scene and gives the impression that you're looking down into a valley of green, then to distant hills.
- Using a greeting from the Friendly Hello stamp set, I stamped directly onto the DSP scene in the upper right-hand corner in Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
- Adhere the New Horizons DSP panel to the Misty Moonlight mat.

#### Inside of Card

 Using a sponge dauber, lightly blend Misty Moonlight ink on the upper two thirds of the white mat. I did not sponge ink in a solid pattern, but rather sponged the ink on randomly to look like clouds.



- Adhere the 1" x 5-1/4" piece of coordinating DSP to the bottom edge of the Basic White cardstock mat.
- Adhere the mat to the inside of the card.

## **Envelope**

• Using Multipurpose Liquid Glue, adhere coordinating piece of DSP to card flap, then fussy cut around envelope flap to finish.
