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## New Horizons Two Panel Sunset Sky Card Instructions

I'm calling this card the Two Panel Sunset Sky card. Look at the glorious colors the sun is throwing up into the clouds! This card features the New Horizons 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper as I'm highlighting a different card each day this week using one of the lovely scenes from this DSP pack. **This card requires minimal supplies!**



## Card Cuts:

### *Card Front*

- Card Base – Cut 1 Thick Basic White cardstock to 11" x 4-1/4", score at 5-1/2"
- Mats for Front of Card – Cut 2 Pale Papaya cardstock to 5-1/4" x 1-7/8"
- Designer Series Paper Panels – Cut 2 New Horizons (pink sky pattern) paper to 5-1/8" x 1-3/4". **Note: You want to cut these strips so that the scene continues from the first panel to the second panel.**
- Sentiment Label – Cut 1 from coordinating piece of DSP. **Note: I used a portion of this DSP from the sky section so that stamping will show up on it.** Cut 1 to 2" x 1-1/4".
- Mat for Sentiment Label – Cut 1 Evening Evergreen cardstock to 2-1/4" x 1-1/2"

### *Inside of Card*

- Coordinating DSP for Inside of Card – Cut 1 at 1" x 4"
- Mat for inside of Card – Cut 1 in Basic White to 4" x 5-1/4"

### *Envelope Flap*

- Coordinating DSP – Cut 1 at 2-3/4" x 6"

## Assembling the Card:

### *Card Front*

- After cutting the two panels from the New Horizons DSP and the Pale Papaya card stock, I adhered each piece of the DSP to the cardstock. **Note: Be sure that when cutting the DSP that the scene continues from the first panel to the second panel.**
- Adhere each panel to the front of the card – making sure there is even space between the panels and the edges of the card front.
- From the 2" x 1-1/4" piece of coordinating DSP, stamp a greeting directly onto the piece of DSP in Evening Evergreen ink.
- Adhere the sentiment label onto the 2-1/4" x 1-1/2" piece of Evening Evergreen cardstock.
- Use Stampin' Dimensionals on the back of the sentiment label and adhere to the front of the card on top of the two already adhered panels. I place the greeting towards the top center of the card.

### *Inside of Card*

- Adhere the 1" strip of coordinating DSP to the Basic White cardstock panel. Place along bottom, short edge.
- Adhere the panel to the inside of the card.
- On the Basic White mat for the inside of the card, use a sponge dauber and streak Pale Papaya and Fresh Freesia ink across the upper portion of this panel to mimic the sunset sky. You can streak the color horizontally or diagonally.

### ***Envelope***

- Using Multipurpose Liquid Glue, adhere coordinating piece of DSP to card flap, then fussy cut around envelope flap to finish.
