Pretty Pansy Card Project Sheet



Card Cuts:

Card Front

- Card Base – Cut 1 Fresh Fesia cardstock to 11" x 4-1/4", score at 5-1/2"
- Mat for Front of Card – Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to 4" x 5-1/4"
- Die Cut Circle – Cut 1 Fresh Fesia to approximately 3-1/4" x 3-1/4"

- Die Cut Pansy Petals 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper – Cut 1 pansy print DSP to approximately 3-1/4" x 3-1/4"
- Strip of Pansy Petals DSP, checkered print in Fresh Fresia – Cut 1 to 4" x 1-1/4"
- Sentiment Label – Cut 1 Basic White to 4" x 7/8"

Inside of Card

- Mat – Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to 4" x 5-1/4"

Envelope Flap

- Coordinating Pansy Petals DSP – Cut 1 at 2-3/4" x 6"

Assembling the Card:

Card Front

- Start by using the Stampin' Cut & Emboss machine to emboss the Basic White mat for the card front. I used the Hammered Metal 3D Embossing Folder.
- Die cut 1 Fresh Fresia cardstock using the largest scalloped circle die from the Layering Circles Dies.
- Die cut 1 Pansy DSP using the largest circle die from the Layering Circles Dies.
- Adhere the Fresh Fresia DSP strip (4" x 1-1/4") to the embossed white card mat. Place approximately 2/3 of the way down.
- Adhere the pansy DSP circle to the Fresh Fresia scalloped circle.
- Using Stampin' Dimensionals, pop up the Pansy circle to overlap the checkered strip of DSP about half way down the mat.
- Stamp the birthday greeting on the small rectangle basic white cardstock and using the Banners Pick a Punch, cut each end. Pop up the sentiment with Stampin' Dimensionals and place on card front to slightly overlap the bottom of the pansy circle. Be careful to only place Stampin' Dimensionals on the bottom portion of the sentiment tag since Stampin' Dimensionals were also used under the pansy circle.
- Tie a small bow using cotton ribbon – leaving long tails on the bow. I currently do not have any Fresh Fresia ribbon so I used cotton ribbon in pale pink and colored the ribbon using Fresh Fresia Stampin' Blends...worked perfectly! Adhere the bow to the top center of the pansy circle using a Mini Glue Dot.
- Place several Bumblebee Trinkets on the card front. I place one below the sentiment tag on the left, one on the upper right of the sentiment tag, and one in the upper right of the card front.
- Adhere the decorated mat to the card base.

Inside of Card

- Adhere the Basic White mat to the inside of the card.

Envelope

- Using Multipurpose Liquid Glue, adhere coordinating piece of DSP to card flap, then fussy cut around envelope flap to finish.
