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Ladybug in Pink Card Project Sheet

These cute little lady bugs are ready for spring! This card works up quickly and the bright colors are cheerful and uplifting.

Card Cuts:

Card Front

- Card Base – Cut 1 Polished Pink to 11" x 4-1/4", score at 5-1/2"
- Mat in Basic White Cardstock – Cut 1 to 5-1/4" x 4"
- Scrap of Basic White cardstock for sentiment label
- Scraps of Basic Black cardstock for punching ladybug bodies
- Scraps of Polished Pink for punching ladybug wings

Inside of Card

- Mat – Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to 5-1/4" x 4"

Project Instructions:

Stamping & Punching

- Using the Label Me Lovely punch, cut out one sentiment label in Basic White cardstock.
- From the Hello Ladybug stamp set, stamp the large leaf in Granny Apple Green three times on the Basic White card mat for the front of the card. Because this image is so large it will cover a large area. I stamped two of the leaves on the left side of the mat, and one on the right side of the mat. Be sure to turn the stamp so the leaves are not in all the same orientation. I stamped the images only partially onto the mat.
- For the mat for the inside of the card stamp the large leaf in Granny Apple Green ink the lower right-hand corner and only stamp a portion of the leaf.
- On the bottom right-hand corner of the front of the envelope, stamp the large leaf in Granny Apple Green.
- Using the flower image from the Hello Ladybug stamp set, stamp the flowers image in Polished Pink on the card front mat, filling in the areas around the leaves that you already stamped.
- Using the same flower image, stamp the image once in Polished Pink on the mat for the inside of the card and next to the partial leaf image.
- Stamp the flower image in Polished Pink once on the lower right-hand corner of the front of the envelope, next to the leaf image that you already stamped.
- Stamp the sentiment on the label in Granny Apple Green.
- Stamp the flower image in Polished Pink on the upper right and lower left of the sentiment label. I only partially stamped the flower image on the label.
- Using the same flower image, stamp the flowers in Polished Pink repeatedly across the envelope flap, being sure to rotate the stamp so the flowers face different directions.
- Using the Ladybug Builder punch, punch out three (3) ladybug bodies in Basic Black cardstock.

- Using the Ladybug Builder punch, punch out three (3) ladybug wings in Polished Pink.
- Stamp the ladybug spots on each set of wings in Tuxedo Black Memento ink.



Putting the Card Together

- Cut two (2) lengths of Polished Pink Open Weave Ribbon to approximately 6" each. The ribbon will run vertically down the right side of the mat for the front of the card and parallel to each other. I positioned the ribbon on my card approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ " from the right side of the mat. Use a small amount of Stampin' Seal on the back of the mat to hold down the ribbon ends at the top and bottom of the mat.
- Use Multipurpose Liquid Adhesive to adhere the ladybug wings to the bodies.
- Apply Stampin' Dimensionals to the backs of the assembled ladybugs and adhere to the left side of the card mat. The ladybugs are running vertically up the left side.
- Apply Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the sentiment label and adhere to the card mat in the lower left corner.
- Using Multipurpose Liquid Adhesive, adhere the finished mat to the card base front.

- Using Matte Black Dots, apply two small and two large dots to each set of wings.
- Adhere the mat to the inside of the card.

The card is complete!
