#### **Project Sheet**



This beautiful pheasant is sitting on a background of Cajun Craze and Evening Evergreen. I used the Painted Pheasant stamp set from the upcoming July-December Mini Catalog, the Beauty of Friendship stamp set and the Stylish Shapes Dies to create this card.

#### 1. Card Cuts:

- Card Base Cut 1 Cajun Craze cardstock to 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", score at 2-1/8" and 4-1/4"
- Mats Cut 2 Basic White cardstock to 2" x 5-3/8"
- DSP Panels Cut 2 Evening Evergreen print from the Pretty Prints 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper to 5-1/4" x 1-7/8"
- Large Circle Die cut 1 Cajun Craze from largest circle die from the Stylish Shapes Dies set
- Smaller Circle Die cut 1 Basic White cardstock from 2nd to largest circle from the Stylish Shapes Dies set
- Scraps of Basic White cardstock for stamping and fussy cutting the pheasant, and stamping and die cutting the sentiment and smaller circle
- Inside Panel Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to 5-3/8" x 4-1/4"



#### **Project Sheet**

- DSP Panel Cut 1 coordinating DSP print in Evening Evergreen to 2" x 5-1/4"
- Envelope Flap Cut 1 coordinating DSP print in Evening Evergreen to 6" x 2-3/4"
- 2. On a piece of scrap white cardstock, stamp the pheasant in Crumb Cake ink. With a black Stampin' Write marker, trace over (darken" the "feather" lines on the pheasant's back, chest, belly and tail. Use the black marker to also darken the Pheasant's eye and under the beak. Using Stampin' Blends in Starry Sky, Cherry Cobbler, Crumb Cake and Cajun Craze, color in the pheasant. Hint: Search images of pheasants on Goggle for a reference on their coloring. I colored the pheasant's head in light and dark shades of Starry Sky. I used Cherry Cobbler to color in the area around the pheasant's eye, his chest and tail section under his wing. I then blended in Cajun Craze on the rest of his body and wing. For the wing I used a combination of Crumb Cake and blended in some streaks of Cherry Cobbler to resemble the wing feathers. The long tail feathers were colored in with Crumb Cake, with a little Cherry Cobbler along the outside of the feathers. Once you're happy with how your pheasant is colored, fussy cut the pheasant using a small pair of scissors or snips.
- 3. Using the small tree leaf shape from the Beauty of Friendship stamp set, stamp the image several times on a scrap piece of cardstock in Evening Evergreen ink. The stamped images of the tree top will resemble bushes. I stamped the image about three times, overlapping the image, then die cut using the 2nd to largest circle from the Stylish Shapes Dies set. I then blended in Balmy Blue for the sky on this circle.
- 4. Stamp the sentiment "I Believe in You" from the Beauty of Friendship stamp set in Evening Evergreen ink onto a scrap piece of white cardstock, then die cut using the 2nd to smallest circle die from the Stylish Shapes Dies set.
- 5. Adhere the 5-1/4" x 1-7/8" DSP panels to their white mats measuring 5-3/8" x 2". Fully open the card base and adhere these units to the two panels on the left, making sure there is an even reveal all around the panels.
- 6. Stamp the grass image from the Painted Pheasant stamp set onto the inside white panel in the lower left corner. Adhere the remaining DSP panel to the right side of the inside panel. Then, adhere this unit to the inside, or right side, of the cardbase.
- 7. Adhere the smaller, stamped circle to the larger Cajun Craze circle. Apply adhesive to only half of the back of this unit, then apply to the far left panel of the card front, being careful to only adhere the circle to the far left panel.
- 8. Using Stampin' Dimensionals, adhere the pheasant to the circle unit. His feet should fall in about the middle of the circle so there is room for the sentiment.
- 9. Using Stampin' Dimensionals, adhere the sentiment to the circle unit, towards the bottom and overlapping the pheasants feet.
- 10. Apply several Rustic Metallic Adhesive-Backed Dots to the card front.
- 11. Adhere the coordinating DSP to the envelope flap and fussy cut around the flap to finish off the envelope.
