

The chickens in the Hey Chuck Bundle have something to say...in a very funny way! You can't help but smile when seeing these feathered friends! I used the Hey Chuck Bundle, some stamping and ink blending to create today's card.

#### Supplies:

- Hey Chuck Bundle
- Stylish Shapes Dies
- Adhesive-Backed Solid Gems
- Blending Brush
- Paper: Basic White, Lemon Lolly, Real Red, Granny Apple Green
- Ink: Tuxedo Black Memento Ink, Balmy Blue, Pumpkin Pie
- Stampin' Blends: Lemon Lolly, Real Red, Pumpkin Pie, Bubble Bath, Copper Clay
- Adhesives: Multipurpose Liquid Glue, Stampin' Dimensionals
- Paper Trimmer
- Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine

#### 1. Card Cuts:

- Card Base Cut 1 Lemon Lolly cardstock to 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", score at 4-1/4"
- Outside & Inside Mats Cut 2 Real Red cardstock to 5-1/8" x 3-7/8"
- Outside & Inside Panels Cut 2 Basic White cardstock to 5" x 3-3/4"
- Sentiment Label Small scrap of Basic White cardstock
- Scraps of Basic White, Granny Apple Green and Lemon Lolly for stamping and/or die cutting
- 2. On one of the white panels, use a blending brush to blend Pumpkin Pie ink onto the lower right corner of the panel. Use a separate blending brush to blend Balmy Blue over the rest of the panel. Be careful not to blend blue ink onto the Pumpkin Pie ink.
- 3. Prepare the following images and use the coordinating dies to cut out:
  - Stamp the chicken onto Basic White cardstock using Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
    Color in the chicken using Lemon Lolly and Copper Clay Stampin' Blends. Color the chicken's beak and feet using a Pumpkin Pie Stampin Blend. Color the chicken's comb using a Real Red Stampin' Blend.
  - Stamp the fence using Tuxedo Black Memento ink and color in using Copper Clay Stampin' Blends
  - Stamp the birthday cake in Tuxedo Black Memento ink and color in using Bubble Bath Stampin' Blends. Color the glow of the candle with a Lemon Lolly Stampin' Blend. Color the candle flame using a Pumpkin Pie blend.
  - Die cut the sun image from Lemon Lolly cardstock, then use a blending brush to color the sun rays with Pumpkin Pie ink
  - Die cut a circle from Granny Apple Green cardstock and use the 2nd to largest circle die from the Stylish Shapes Dies set to cut out. Use a paper trimmer to cut the circle. Cut the circle so that one side is smaller than the other.


- 4. Stamp the sentiment "It's your Birthday!" in Tuxedo Black Memento ink onto a scrap piece of Basic White cardstock. Use the 2nd to smallest die from the Stylish Shapes Dies set to cut out.
- 5. Adhere the sun image behind the smaller of the green half circles, then adhere the half circles to the ink blended panel. The half circles will serve as green hills! The hill and sun image should be placed over where you blended Pumpkin Pie ink.
- 6. Adhere the fence on top of the green hill with the sun.
- 7. Adhere the birthday cake to the chicken's wing, then adhere the chicken on the opposite "hill" using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 8. Adhere the sentiment label to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 9. Adhere the finished panel to one of the Real Red mats, then adhere to the card front.
- 10. On the second white panel, stamp the sentiment "You've got something to crow about" in Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Stamp a second image of a chicken onto the lower right of this panel in Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color in the image of the chicken using Lemon Lolly and Pumpkin Pie Stampin' Blends. Adhere the panel to the second Real Red mat, then adhere the panel to the inside of the card.



- 11. Partially stamp the chicken image onto the lower front of the envelope using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color in the chicken using Lemon Lolly and Pumpkin Pie Stampin' Blends.
- 12. Stamp the birthday cake image onto the envelope flap using Tuxedo Black Memento ink and color in using Bubble Bath, Lemon Lolly and Pumpkin Pie Stampin' Blends.
- 13. Adhere several Lemon Lolly Adhesive-Backed Solid Gems to the card front to complete the card.
