
Project Sheet - Sept 12 2024



I can't seem to get enough of the beautiful **Season of Green & Gold 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper** with all of the pretty gold highlights! I used this paper along with the **Golden Greenery Bundle** and the **Greetings of the Season Stamp Set** to create today's card. Bonus...the Golden Greenery Dies cut out images from the Season of Green & Gold Designer Series Paper! Let's get started!

Supplies:

- Season of Green & Gold 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper
- Golden Greenery Bundle
- Greetings of the Season Stamp Set
- Drusy Adhesive-Backed Embellishments
- Natural Tones Linen Thread
- · Cardstock: Garden Green, Basic Black, Basic White
- Ink: Garden Green, Tuxedo Black Memento Ink

1. Card Cuts:

- Card Base Cut 1 Garden Green cardstock to 8-1/2" x 5-1/2, score at 4-1/4"
- Outside & Inside Mats Cut 2 Basic Black cardstock to 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"

Season of Green & Gold Holiday Card

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- DSP Panel Cut 1 multi greenery print to 5-1/4" x 4"
- Small Rectangular DSP Panel Cut 1 Very Vanilla and dotted print from the Season of Green & Gold DSP to 3-3/4" x 3"
- Mat for Small Rectangular DSP Panel Cut 1 Basic Black cardstock to 3-7/8" x 3-1/8"
- Greenery for Card Front Die cut 2 pine boughs and 1 greenery sprig using the Golden Greenery Dies and cut from the Season of Green & Gold Designer Series Paper.
- Sentiment Label Cut 1 Garden Green cardstock to 3-1/2" x 7/8"
- Inside Panel Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to 5-1/4" x 4"
- Envelope Flap Cut 1 coordinating piece of designer series paper to 6" x 2-1/4"
- 2. Adhere the 5-1/4" x 4" DSP Panel to one of the Basic Black mats, then adhere this to the card front using liquid glue or Stampin' Seal.
- 3. Adhere the Small Rectangular DSP Panel (the polka dot print) to the small Basic Black Mat. Adhere this panel to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals and position the panel so that the right edge is flush with the right edge of the card front. Center the panel from top to bottom.
- 4. Arrange the two die cut pine boughs from the Season of Green & Gold Designer Series Paper, and the green sprig - also die cut from the same paper - onto the small rectangular unit on the card front. I first adhered the two pine boughs to the top of the panel, then adhered the greenery sprig in the center of this arrangement. It was necessary to trim the end of one of the pine boughs before gluing.


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- 5. On the sentiment label, use the Greetings of the Season Stamp Set to stamp the "Happy" and "Holidays" sentiments onto the sentiment label. The sentiment should be stamped towards the right of the label in Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Use a pair of paper snips to cut a banner end on the left side of the label. Adhere the label over the bottom of the small rectangular unit so that the bottom edge of the label is approximately a 1/2" from the bottom of the rectangular unit. Use a combination of liquid glue and Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the sentiment label.
- 6. From the Greetings of the Season Stamp Set, stamp the "It's the most wonderful time of the year" sentiment in Tuxedo Black ink onto the inside panel. Use the two step stamps from the Golden Greenery Stamp Set to stamp the pine bough onto the lower corner in Garden Green ink. The background of the pine bough is in second-generation stamped Garden Green, and the detailed image was first generation stamped in Garden Green ink.

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


- 7. Tie a double bow using Garden Green Natural Tones Linen Thread, then adhere the bow to the top of the greenery arrangement on the card front using a Mini Glue Dot.
- 8. Adhere three Drusy Adhesive-Backed Embellishments in the champagne color to the card front
- 9. Repeat stamping of the pine bough in Garden Green ink onto the envelope front using the two step stamps from the Golden Greenery Stamp Set.
- 10. Adhere the coordinating piece of designer series paper to the envelope flap and use a small pair of scissors or paper snips to trim the excess paper away from the flap.

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This completes the card! The Season of Green & Gold Designer Series Paper combined with the Golden Greenery Bundle and the Greetings of the Season Stamp Set make for a very elegant card...you can't go wrong!
