

This pretty little note card was created using the *Pretty Petals Bundle* and a striped print in Shy Shamrock from the *2024-2026 In Color 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper*. I thought about adding a sentiment (and you can easily do so for your card) but I liked the simplicity of a note card. The Pretty Petals Bundle is a new Online Exclusive that will be available in the online store on November 5.

- Countryside Corners Dies
- Glossy Dots Assortment
- Shy Shamrock Bordered Ribbon
- Sponge Daubers

- Ink: Shy Shamrock, Petunia Pop

- 1. Card Cuts:

Pretty Petals Note Card



- Card Base Cut 1 Shy Shamrock cardstock to 8-1/2" x 5-1/2, score at 4-1/4"
- Outside Panel Cut 1 Petunia Pop cardstock to 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"
- DSP Octagon Cut 1 Shy Shamrock striped print from the 2024-2026 In Color Designer Series Paper to approximately 5" x 3-1/2"
- Panel for Stamping Flowers Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to approximately 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"
- White Cardstock Octagon Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to ,4-1/2" x 2-3/4"
- Inside Mat Cut 1 Petunia Pop cardstock to 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"
- Inside Panel Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to 5-1/4" x 4"
- Envelope Flap Cut 1 piece of coordinating designer series paper to 6" x 2-1/4"
- 2. On the Petunia Pop cardstock Outside Panel, use the large multi-floral image from the Pretty Petals Stamp Set and stamp flowers across the entire panel in Petunia Pop ink. Because the stamps in the Pretty Petals Stamp Set are distinctive, I found it helpful to ink up the stamp then use a Sponge Dauber to tap the inked surface of the stamp to make sure the ink was even across the surface. Once you have stamped over the entire panel, adhere the panel to the card front using liquid glue or Stampin' Seal.
- 3. Use the Countryside Corners Dies to cut out two octagons one from the Shy Shamrock striped print from the 2-24-2026 In Color Designer Series Paper and one from white cardstock. I used the second from largest die to cut out the striped print designer series paper and the third from largest die to cut out the white cardstock panel.
- 4. On the white octagon, use the two-step stamps to first stamp the large leaf cluster in Shy Shamrock ink, then stamp the flowers in Petunia Pop ink. These images will line up with each other. Note: Use a two different Sponge Daubers to tap the surface of the inked stamps before stamping to make sure you have an even application of ink across the stamp. Adhere the image of the stamped flowers to the larger striped octagon then adhere this to the center of the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.


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- 5. On the 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" piece of white cardstock, stamp just the flowers in Petunia Pop ink. Use a Petunia Pop Stampin' Blend to darken the flower centers on the larger of the stamped flowers. Then use the coordinating die from the Pretty Petals Dies to cut out the stamped flowers. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the flowers to the front of the stamped octagon image matching up the previously stamped flowers on the octagon with the die cut flowers. Note that you will need to cut down the Stampin' Dimensionals for the smaller flowers.
- 6. On the Inside Panel, use the two-step stamps to partially stamp the leaves and flowers in Shy Shamrock and Petunia Pop, respectively, in the lower corner of the panel. Adhere the panel to the Petunia Pop mat, then adhere this to the inside of the card.

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- 7. Stamp the same leaf and flower images onto the front of the envelope front using Shy Shamrock and Petunia Pop ink.
- 8. Adhere the coordinating piece of designer series paper to the envelope flap and use a small pair of scissors or paper snips to trim the excess paper away from the flap.
- 9. Tie a small bow from Shy Shamrock Bordered Ribbon and adhere the ribbon to the card front at the base of the stamped flower bouquet using a Mini Glue Dot.
- 10. Adhere three Pool Party Glossy Dots to the center octagon on the card front to complete the card.

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This completes the card! I love the popped-up flowers on this card front...it provides so much dimension and is so pretty!
