Project Sheet - Oct 9 2024

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I have another sneak peek for you today of new Online Exclusive products coming on November 5. I used the adorable *Umbrella Days Bundle* (stamps and dies) along with the *Regal Winter* 12" x 12" *Designer Series Paper* to create this friendship card. This card uses a minimal amount of supplies. I couldn't wait to have a play with this bundle! I hope you enjoy the card!

Supplies:

- Umbrella Days Bundle
- Regal Winter 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper
- Blooming Pearls
- Cardstock: Pretty Peacock, Berry Burst, Basic Black, Daffodil Delight, Basic White
- Ink: Night of Navy, Crushed Curry

1. Card Cuts:

- Card Base Cut 1 Pretty Peacock cardstock to 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", score at 4-1/4"
- Outside & Inside Mats Cut 2 Berry Burst cardstock to 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"
- Outside & Inside Panels Cut 2 Basic White cardstock to 5-1/4" x 4"
- Umbrella Panels 1 small scrap of multi-flower print from the Regal Winter 12" x 12"
 Designer Series Paper


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- Boots Small scrap of Daffodil Delight cardstock
- Bush & Cloud Small scraps of Pretty Peacock and Basic Black cardstock
- Envelope Flap 1 coordinating piece of designer series paper measuring 6" x 2-1/4"
- 2. Using the Umbrella Days Stamp Set, third generation stamp the raindrop image across the upper two thirds of one of the 5-1/4" x 4" white panels. I stamped the raindrops in Night of Navy ink because I wanted to use colors contained in the Regal Winter Designer Series Paper. Note: To third generation stamp, ink the stamp, then stamp two times onto a scrap piece of paper, then stamp onto the panel on the third stamping. Next, stamp the "You are the umbrella to my rainy days" sentiment onto the lower right corner of the panel. Adhere the stamped panel to one of the Berry Burst mats, then adhere this to the card front using liquid glue or Stampin' Seal.
- 3. Using the Umbrella Days Dies, die cut the following and follow any additional directions:
 - Die cut 1 silhouette of the girl from Basic Black cardstock
 - Die cut 1 umbrella handle from Basic Black cardstock. Trim the umbrella handle down, then adhere the umbrella handle to the black silhouette of the girl. I have only the handle showing. Refer to photos.
 - Die cut 1 of the umbrella panels from a multi-floral print from the Regal Winter 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper. Keeping the panels in the order that they were die cut, glue the pieces to the black silhouette of the umbrella. There will be a small gap of black showing through the pieces.
 - Die cut 1 large bush from Pretty Peacock cardstock. Note that the large die can be used as either a bush or a cloud.
 - Die cut 1 small cloud from Basic Black cardstock.
 - On a small piece of Daffodil Delight cardstock, stamp just the image of the girl's boots in Crushed Curry ink. Use a pair of paper snips to fussy cut around the tops of the boots, then adhere the boots to the black silhouette of the girl.

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
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- 4. Adhere the silhouette of the girl using liquid glue or Stampin' Seal to the card front and position to the left of the stamped sentiment. Adhere the Pretty Peacock bush over the bottom of the girl's boots using Stampin' Dimensionals. Adhere the black cloud to the upper right of the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 5. On the inside panel, adhere the 4" x 3/4" strip of designer series paper to the bottom of the white inside panel measuring 5-1/4" x 4" using liquid glue or Stampin' Seal. Adhere the inside panel to the remaining Berry Burst mat, then adhere this to the inside of the card.

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- 6. Adhere the coordinating piece of designer series paper to the envelope flap and use a small pair of scissors or paper snips to trim the excess paper away from the envelope flap.
- 7. Adhere three Pretty Peacock Blooming Pearls to the card front.

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This completes the card! This was a quick and easy card to create! The girl image can be stamped and colored or presented as a silhouette as I did on this card. I love the pops of color that the umbrella and boots provide on the silhouette!
