Supplies:

- Terrific Toadstools Bundle (Item #164790 - Available Jan 7)
- Toadstool Gardens 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper (Item #164942 - Available Jan 7)
- Something Fancy Dies
- Linen Thread
- Glossy Dots Assortment
- Cardstock: Early Espresso, Basic White
- Ink: Melon Mambo, Early Espresso, Pumpkin Pie

1. Card Cuts:

- Card Base - Cut 1 Early Espresso cardstock to 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", score at 4-1/4"
- DSP Panel #1 - Cut 1 leaf sprig print from the Toadstool Gardens Designer Series Paper to 5-1/4" x 4"
- DSP Panel #2 - Cut 1 Melon Mambo cross hatch print to 5-1/4" x 1-1/4"
- Sentiment Label - Cut 1 piece of Early Espresso print from the Toadstool Gardens Designer Series Paper to approximately 3" x 1"
- Toadstool Tops - Toadstool Gardens print in Early Espresso and Basic White cardstock
- Toadstool Stems - Early Espresso cardstock

- Inside Panel - Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to 5-1/4" x 4"
 - Envelope Flap - Cut 1 coordinating piece of designer series paper to 6" x 2-1/4"
2. Adhere the Melon Mambo cross hatch print DSP Panel #2 and adhere to DSP Panel #1. Center the strip from top to bottom. Then adhere the panel to the card front using liquid glue or Stampin' Seal.
 3. Prepare the Toadstools for the Card Front:
 - From a piece of the Toadstool Gardens in the Early Espresso print, second-generation stamp the smaller mushroom top two times in Early Espresso ink. Use the Terrific Toadstools Punch to punch out the mushroom tops.
 - On a scrap piece of white cardstock, stamp the small mushroom top in Melon Mambo ink, then use the Terrific Toadstools Punch to punch out the top.
 - Punch out three toadstool stems from Early Espresso cardstock using the Terrific Toadstools Punch.
 - Adhere the stems to each of the mushrooms



4. Adhere the two Early Espresso toadstools across the Melon Mambo strip on the card front being sure to leave room in the center for the Melon Mambo toadstool. Use liquid glue or Stampin' Seal to adhere. Then adhere the Melon Mambo toadstool in the center between the two Early Espresso toadstools using Stampin' Dimensionals.
5. Tie a bow with Linen Thread and adhere the bow on the upper portion of the stem on the Melon Mambo toadstool. I used a small drop of liquid glue to adhere the bow into place. Note that the bow ends should be about 2" long on each side. The bow ends will hang underneath the sentiment label once it is adhered.
6. On a piece of the Early Espresso print from the Toadstool Gardens Designer Series Paper, stamp the "Just a little thank you" sentiment in Early Espresso ink. Use the rectangular angled die from the Something Fancy Dies to cut out the sentiment. Adhere the sentiment across the three toadstool stems using Stampin' Dimensionals. Be sure the bow ends are hanging underneath the sentiment label.
7. On the inside panel, stamp the "you are Magical" sentiment in Melon Mambo ink. Then stamp the three-stem image in Early Espresso ink onto the lower corner of the panel. Stamp the three small toadstools on top of the stems in Melon Mambo ink. Stamp the small toadstool stem next to the three mushrooms in Early Espresso ink, and the small toadstool top in Pumpkin Pie ink. Adhere the panel to the inside of the card.

8. Repeat stamping of the three mushrooms and the small mushroom and their stems onto the envelope front using the same ink colors as you did in Step #7 above.
9. Adhere the coordinating piece of designer series paper to the envelope flap and use a small pair of scissors or paper snips to trim the excess paper away from the flap.
10. Adhere three Melon Mambo Glossy Dots to the card front to complete the project.

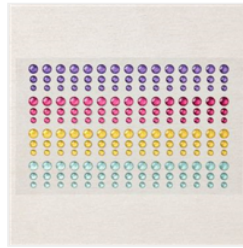

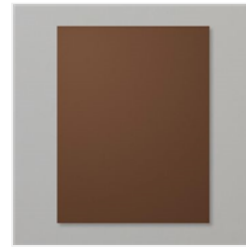

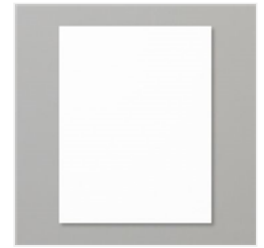
